



Tips for a diverse approach

1. Give different students **as much** and **equivalent** turns.
2. **Compliment** all students both for their performances, competence and initiative, and for enthusiasm and good behavior.
3. Search for **topics that appeal** to all of your students.
4. **Constructive**, caring, **positive** and concrete feedback works for everyone.
5. **Vary** the didactic approach and active working methods within an assignment.
6. Vary in group work consciously the **different roles**.
7. Expect **contributions** of all pupils.
8. Provide a **non gender-stereotype example** to professions, like Sara the construction worker.
9. Set a **good example**, analyze your teaching materials and decoration of your class/school on gender balance.
10. A **good teaching plan** is the beginning of a good activity.
11. Give a **context** to the activity, use storytelling.
12. Ask **fathers and mothers** to help.



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
